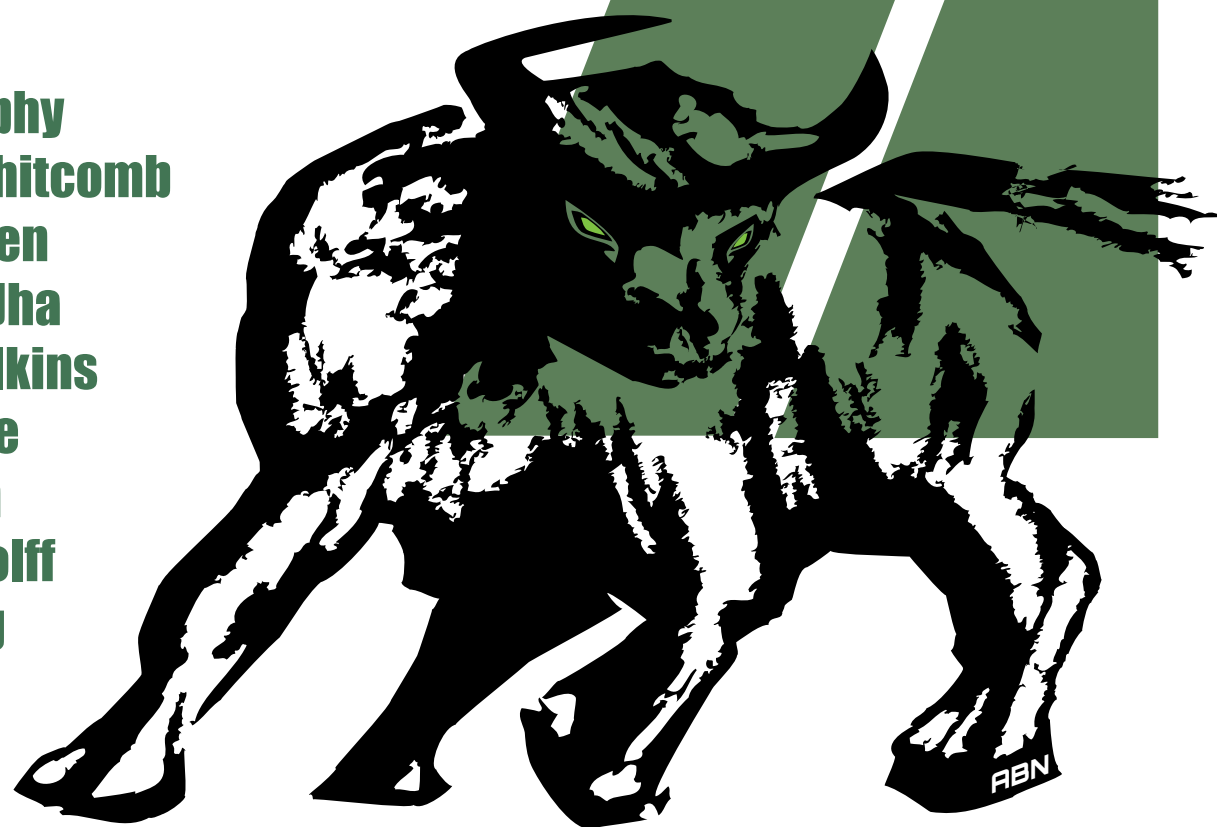

We had a great time with Cristian from Sunhydraulics this July. His corvette almost looks like it has the same color scheme as our car!

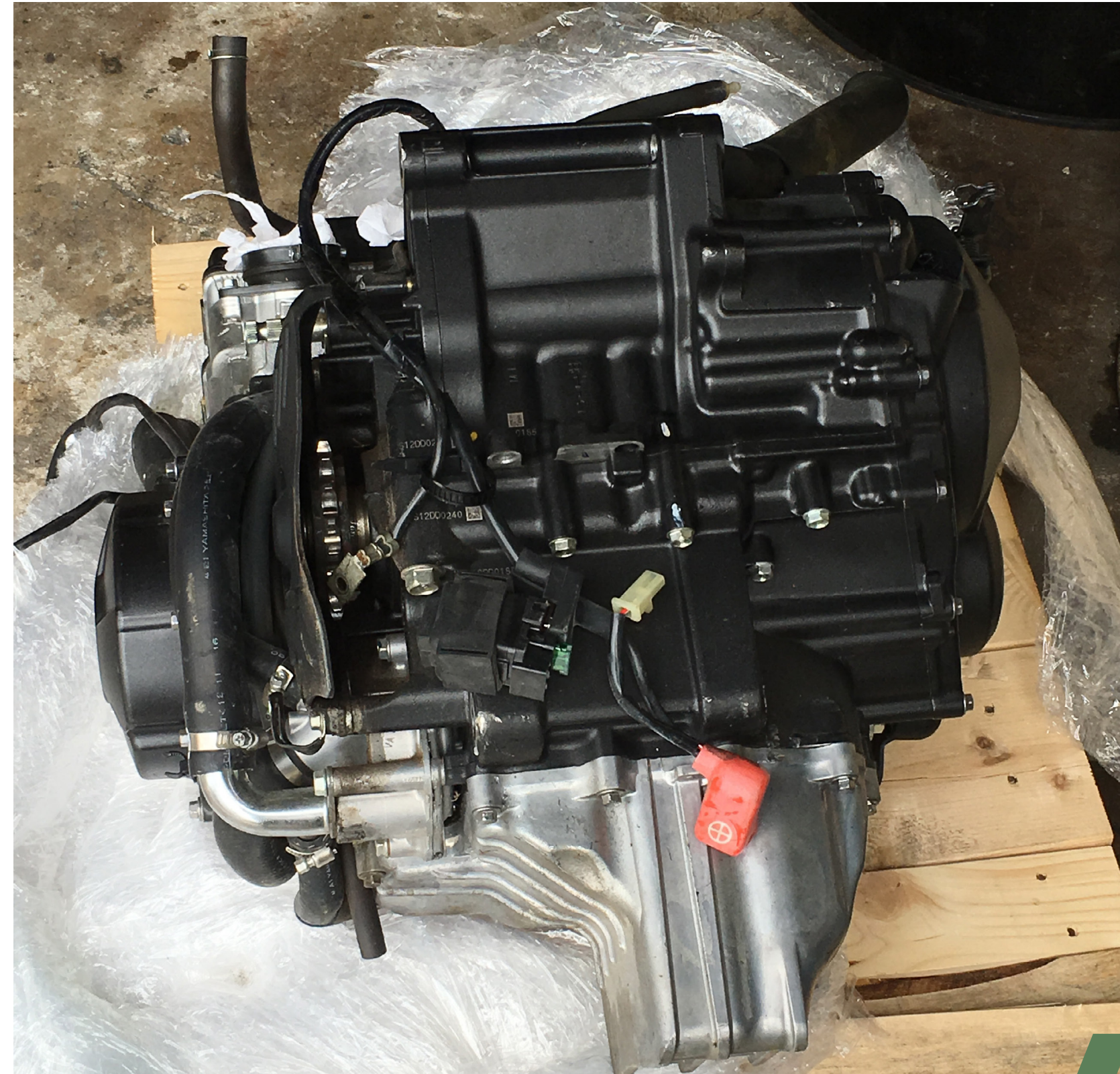
